OSCAR CABALLERO:

Studies Background:

Oscar Caballero began his studies of Argentine Folklore Dances at the age of 6 in his native Bahía Blanca, Province of Buenos Aires. He entered the course of Proficiency in Folkloric Dances at the Teatro Municipal de Bahía Blanca under the program of the National School of Dances. Took Ballet lessons with Clotilde Freyre at the Buenos Aires Institute of the Dance and at the Institute of Liliana Belfiore.

Work Background:

At the age of 17 he moved to Buenos Aires where he danced at the Argentina Folk Ballet directed by Nora and Raul Dinzelbacher, soon he passed to the Ballet of Celia Queiró and Jorge Lance. He was a season with Juan Carlos Copes dancing Tango. He danced with the Ballet of Mario Machaco and Norma Re. Finally, in 1980 he entered the Ballet Brandsen in which he danced during 6 years.

During the last years that he was part of the Ballet Brandsen he started to work with Perla Aguirre playing native instruments and combining the dance with the music.

He worked with Antonio Tarragó Ros as choreographer for the Proyecto Fronteras and Proyecto Naturaleza.

In 1990 he contacted Rodolfo Dinzel. With him he worked during 10 years. He danced to the Osvaldo Pugliese Orchestra. He performed in different places during the Tango Week in Buenos Aires. He was professor of the Universidad del Tango de Buenos Aires, Argentina.

Historian of Tango and Argentine popular dances, showed his dance in several Universities of the United States: Augustana College, Davenport, North St. Ambrose, Western Illinois. Knox College, Iowa City... etc. On May 3rd 1991 he received the Diploma of Honor at Augustana College, Rock Island for the international contribution of education and university culture.

He toured in Paraguay, Bolivia, Chile, Uruguay, Colombia, Aruba, Canada and the U.S.A. He worked in television with excellent artists of international reputation, Taught TV Tango lessons in the program "Movete Gergina" with Georgina Barbarossa (America 2). He performed on TV program "Viernes de Esco" with Héctor Larrea (ATC) celebrating the Semana del Tango directing his own group of dancers. Choreographer for Sábado Gigante at Univision Network in 2007.

He held tango lessons at the Centro Cultural Martín Fierro, hired by the Undersecretary's office of the Municipality of Avellaneda. In 1997 he was named Jury for the Undersecretary's office of Culture of the Province of Buenos.

He also worked with traditional characters of the Buenos Aires's milonga such as Lampaso, Anotio Torado, Petroleo, Jose Arena and Lavandina.

Among the places that offer Tourist Tango Shows in Buenos Aires he danced at Mitos Argentinos, La Ventana, Señor Tango, Casablanca, La Cumparsita, A Media Luz, Taconeando, El Balcón, etc.

Studies Background:

Born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, embraced the dancing world at the age of nine pouring in it all her histrionic ability.

She took Ballet lessons with Beatriz Ferrary.

She studied at the Escuela Nacional de Danzas N° 2 in Buenos Aires. She also took Ballet lessons with Alfredo Gurquel and Modern Dance Lessons with Claudia Carbonel and Freddy Romero. In Israel she trained with the Israeli Company “Coll Vedemama”.

She has also taken piano lessons with Mirta Irusta and Antonio De Raco in Buenos Aires.

Work Background:

Danced at the Teatro Municipal Gral. San Martin and showed in Europe her skills in various opportunities. She was teacher and choreographer for the “Chubut Tango” and the “Chubut Danza” Ballet both in Tango and Contemporary dance.

THE TANGO TIMES DANCE COMPANY

The Creation of the Tango Times Dance Company:

Since the year 2000, Oscar Caballero and Roxana Garber have been spreading the Tango and the Argentine Folklore Dances in South Florida throughout their lessons, workshops and shows.

These two diffusers of the national culture work untiringly to manage to transmit the beauty and depth of our enriched Argentine inheritance. For this matter, on year 2001 they founded the Tango Times Dance Company with its bases in Miami, FL. At this school they teach Tango and Argentine Folklore to students with diversity ethnics' characteristics. There are also technique lessons in modern dance focusing in scenic movements of the Argentine dances. The facilities of the studio are the house of the dance company where the dancers, not only work the corporal issue of the dance, but also study history and learn to investigate. Thus, responsibly and with maturity, the choreographies are made and the theater scripts of each show are solved.

At the moment, the Tango Times Dance Company produces two great performances a year at the Manuel Artime Theater of the City of Miami, FL. under the direction of its creators. The first one is in July commemorating the Argentine Independence day with Tango and Folklore; the second one is during the month of December celebrating the International Day of Tango. Both shows are being held with independent funds with the support of the Consulate General of the Argentine Republic in Miami. It is for that reason that the company looks for the support of important companies to solve the publicity of the event. Nevertheless, the presentations of the Tango Times Dance Company, are not limited to those two annual appearances, it is also hired by institutions for big events such as "Lluvia de Estrellas", "Generosity Pole Cup", "Big Brothers Big Sisters", "Symphony of the Americas", etc.
